#GIVINGTUESDAYNOW IS A GLOBAL DAY OF GIVING AND UNITY, SET TO TAKE PLACE ON MAY 5, 2020 AS AN EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO THE UNPRECEDENTED NEED CAUSED BY COVID-19.

#GivingTuesday is a widespread campaign designed to drive an influx of generosity, citizen engagement, business and philanthropy activation, and support for communities and nonprofits around the world. #GivingTuesday is usually held in December, but this year in light of needs sparked by COVID-19, a coalition has emerged to host an additional #GivingTuesday on May 5th, called #GivingTuesdayNow.


